The GSC Program is a rich program filled with many opportunities for students to increase their international knowledge and skills. We seek to admit only dedicated, motivated and responsible students, passionate about international topics.

The total estimated work load of participation in the GSC is approximately **15 hours per calendar month**, from October to May.

In addition to the individual aspect of the GSC, the group project provides invaluable experience working in small team situations. It is important to realize that the actions of each student have a direct effect on the other members of the team and the GSC as a whole. Each member is expected to participate fully both as a GSC member overall and as a member of a small team, in order to benefit fully from the GSC experience.

While the GSC program offers students many financial advantages since it is free to all participants, we also incur many costs due to student event admission and training/workshop fees, in addition to other expenses. Therefore, in order to maintain a program with serious, motivated students and to defray program costs, a fee schedule will be imposed based on the discretion of the GSC Coordinator for all students who do not complete the GSC Program.
