# Frequently Asked Questions

## **NOMINATION CRITERIA?**

3.0 GPA or higher; junior standing; one semester at Baruch College. Complete Baruch Application to Study Abroad and the exchange interview.

## **VISA PROCESS?**

Upon nomination, and once the official university acceptance letter has been received, students should apply for a visa through Campus France. Once students receive approval from Campus France, they must schedule an appointment with the Visa Application Center in NYC.

## **LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS?**

Baruch exchange students are required to take a semester-long French language course (minimum 3 credits), at their level - and are required to take a one-credit course on French culture and civilization.

## **COURSE OFFERINGS?**

Students enrolling in the SELF (Study in English in Lyon, France) program may choose from a range of courses in business, the humanities, and/or social sciences. Students who can study in French are eligible to enroll in courses in a very wide range of disciplines.

## **CAMPUS LIFE?**

The university offers on-campus Welcome Desks to help exchange students with their needs. The International Office at Jean Moulin University organizes a range of cultural and sport activities for exchange students.

## **HOUSING?**

Exchange students may pay a small fee to Jean Moulin University for help in finding accommodation either in CROUS university residences, in private residences, or with a host family. Students should search for housing early.
