Advising Recommendations/Reminders/Tips
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BUS 9601 should be taken in final term as the only course remaining or [1] flexible or general elective (if required) course. We recommend students to take a maximum of 6 credits in their 1st semester of study to balance academic workload along with other commitments. Students on an F-1 Visa will need to register for 9 credits to be considered full-time. In addition, students on an F-1 visa are limited to one online course per semester and one hybrid course per semester (fall and spring only). For clarification on this, please reach out to the International Students Services Center (ISSC). You need a cumulative GPA of 3.0 to be in good academic standing.
